Distance from UAE to China The distance from the UAE (Dubai) to Beijing, China, is approximately 5,900 kilometers (3,666 miles). A direct flight takes around 7–8 hours.





Day 1: Arrival in Beijing

Morning:

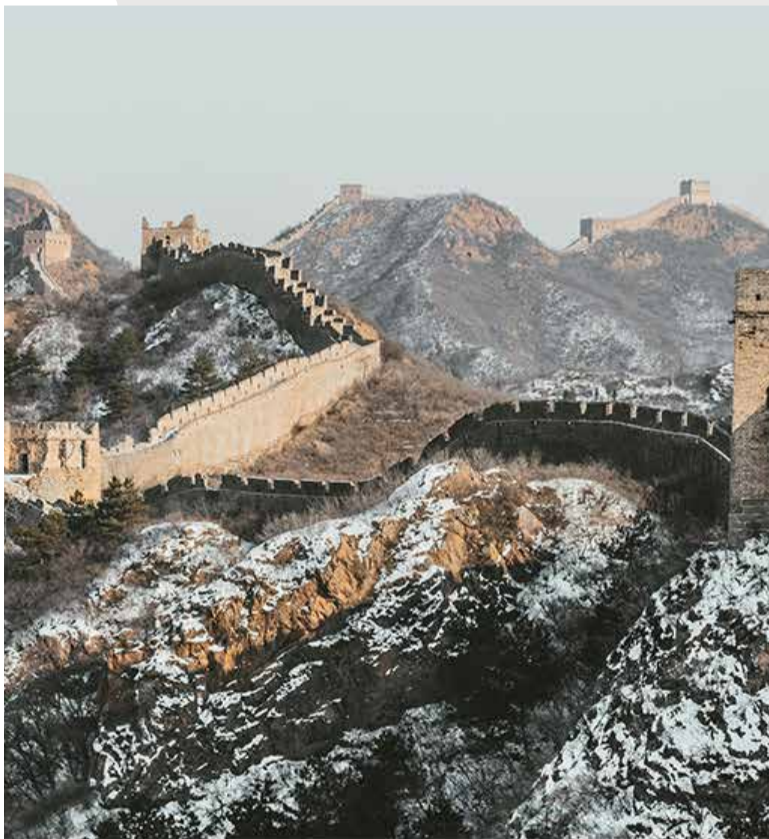

Stroll along Nanjing Road, a bustling shopping street.

Evening:

Depart from Shanghai for your return to the UAE or your next destination.
